It's summer tax time again and this year, per the State of Michigan, we are now collecting 1/3 of the County Operating Tax along with the State Education Tax.

With the new tax forms, please remember to return only the top portion with your payment, the bottom half along with your cancelled check is your receipt. We no longer have receipts to mail back to you, so please keep the bottom half.

Taxes are due by September 14,2005 without penalty, and after that date as per the notice on the tax forms penalties are added. Please send all remittances to;
